



Overview

Designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1985, Old Québec is the most intact fortified town north of Mexico, retaining its colonial architecture for over 400 years. It is the historic and cultural heart of Québec City, and the birthplace of French North America. * Rue Saint-Jean is one of Québec City's oldest commercial streets. Today it continues to be a very popular spot, with its street performers, tourists and workers moving to and from it. The street is pedestrian only on summer week-ends. The available property is situated inside the fortified walls, making it a part of famous Old-Quebec.

This property is located on one of Quebec city's most highly trafficked arterials within a dynamic and vibrant area, providing premium brand exposure and signage opportunities. The historic building is well known by Quebec's residents and has been used for well known brands to be their flagship building. It is also the only building in Old Quebec to have a basement level for storage.




